

Calling all Euchre and game


**players!** It is time to dust off all those board games you love to play. Join us Saturday, October 13th at 6:30pm at the



#### **Financial Report for August, 2018**

Sorry to say, but August was not a shining month—financially—for Trinity Church. Although we had a small carryover from July, we experienced greater than normal expenses in August. As a result, our expenses for the month exceeded our revenue by \$3,799.83 leaving us in a negative position of -\$2,317.14.

July's maintenance expenses were heavier than normal. Many things just needed to be fixed. Just like at home. When something breaks, we fix it. And the utility bills were higher, too. That comes with air-conditioning and the electricity to power it. And August always brings the new "budget" gas bill (\$827/month). Based on its increase, the gas company must be predicting a cold winter and expecting us to use more gas. We also purchased more

educational materials that are always needed at this time of year as we go into the fall and winter seasons.

So far, as we start into September, things are looking somewhat better. Attendance at worship is up and contributions seem to be increasing as well.
